Important - Voting by proxy

A Life Member or Ordinary Member, entitled to attend and vote at the AGM, may only appoint another person as a proxy in either of the following two situations:

1. Inability to attend the AGM due to illness (this must be evidenced by a medical certificate); or
2. Absence from Brisbane (this must be evidenced by a copy of the itinerary).

Also, please note that multiple proxies are not permissible and the person appointed as a proxy need not be a member of HMA.

Every signature on the Proxy Form shall be witnessed by a Justice of Peace or any other mention person mentioned in Schedule 1 to the Land Title Act 1994 (QId).

To be effective, the proxy must be received by the (Acting) Secretary of HMA no later than 10 am on Saturday, 18 July 2015.
